Anyone that has visited our school will know how much importance is placed on working in partnership to give our children the best possible education not only academically but also socially, morally and spiritually. I therefore feel it is important we reflect on some of the many successes that are taking place.

Academically - Children at St. Joseph's achieve well and this is supported by published data for 2017-18 where 73% of children meet the national standard in Reading, writing and maths compared to 64% nationally by the end of KS2 (School performance data can be found on the school website under the 'Our School' tab).

Socially - The St. Joseph's buddy system demonstrates just how well children interact with others and the manners seen in all classes are excellent. Children's conversations observed in lessons, at lunch and break times demonstrate just how much they are growing socially. Our

children's growing knowledge of internet safety will help them to live in a responsible society, alongside this, the introduction of mindfulness into the school will also add to their ability to cope socially.

Morally- Children at St. Joseph's are able to articulate what is right and wrong and the behaviour across the school is excellent. Children are able to model the values taught and we celebrate this weekly in our praise assembly.

Spiritually - You only have to attend weekly Mass to see how much respect our children have for the Catholic Life of the school. Children in our school are able to talk about spirituality openly and honestly and they will independently ask to pray for people in need. The introduction of our school chapel and Faith Ambassadors will further enhance this. As well as the excellent partnership with the Church.
